

## A Legacy in Stone at the Veterans' Memorial Park

Legacy Stones are solid granite stone inscribed with the names of persons whom you wish to recognize and honor with a profound and lasting tribute. Legacy Stone purchasers can also submit information to a registry. The registry will hold individual histories about each of those for whom the stones have been placed. Those histories can contain photos, letters, stories, news-clippings, poems and/or thoughts by or about the honoree. It is the Stone, combined with the pages of the registry, which create the true legacy.
